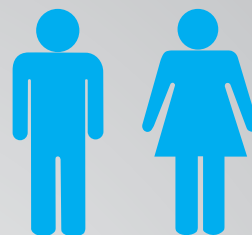
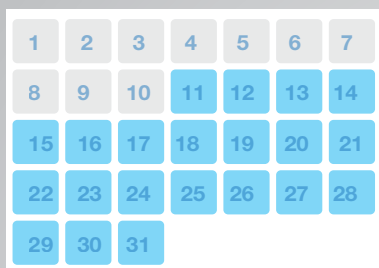


# What do Scottish acute hospitals look like?

Characteristics of NHS acute adult and paediatric hospitals

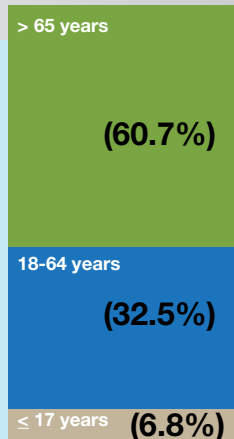


Male to female ratio **1:1.2**

**3.8 days**

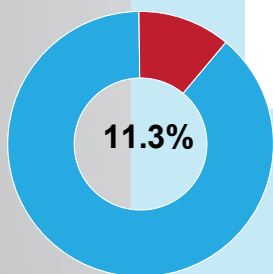
Data from **11585** eligible patients in **702** wards in **40** hospitals



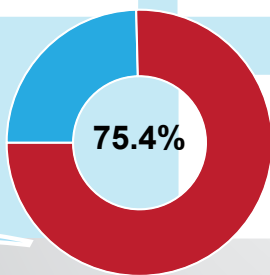
The median age of patients was

**71** years

**11.3%** of staff surveyed were carrying personal ABHR



**75.4%** of beds had ABHR at point of care



The occupancy of hospital beds in surveyed wards was

**86.5%**



Alcohol-based hand rub consumption in hospitals was

**38.6 litres** per 1000 patient days

Hospitals had

**1.4 WTE**

infection prevention and control nurses per 250 beds, and

**0.3 WTE**

staff with responsibility for antimicrobial stewardship per 250 beds
