Rent reimbursement - GP234 form reminder

All practices that wish to claim for reimbursement of practice rental costs for financial year 2022/23 are required to submit an up to date GP234 form to us by **28 February 2022**. This will make sure you receive payment for all four quarters of the financial year 2022/23 if you are eligible for this allowance.

As detailed in <u>PCA(D)(2022)01</u>, the pre-pandemic arrangements that all practices require to return a declaration of the proportion that their practice's total earnings, in their most recent financial year, was attributable to NHS earnings has been reinstated. Please make sure you complete the form fully, including part 3, and make sure the form is completed by your accountant.

Amendment 154 to the Statement of Dental Remuneration (SDR)

<u>PCA(D)(2022)1</u> advises of <u>Amendment 154 to the Statement of Dental</u>
<u>Remuneration (SDR)</u> which takes effect from 1 February 2022. In particular, the Memorandum introduces changes to item 1 Examination and Report, item 2 Procedures to Assist Diagnosis and Treatment Planning and Section X Treatment under Capitation.

Backdated Fee Increase

PCA(D)(2021)7 advised that from 1 December 2021 the revised Determination I to the Statement of Dental Remuneration (SDR) will come into effect with a 3% increase in the fee scale for all courses of treatment started on or after 1 December 2021. The fee increase will be backdated for courses of treatment started on or after 1 April 2021 but before 1 December 2021, and for any capitation and continuing care payments made for that period. As NHS dental contractors are continuing to receive emergency support payments the Scottish Government will also apply a 3% increase based on the value of financial support payments, which will be backdated to 1 April 2021.

This backdated payment has been made in the January paid February 2022 schedule.

Changes to Dental Activity Measures (DAM) reports

We were advised by the Scottish Government to implement a change to ensure that all training activity be included in future Dental Activity Measure reporting with effect from the January paid February 2022 payment schedule.

These reports are for information only and to allow you to monitor your level of NHS activity in line with the guidance set out in CDO(2021)7 which was issued on 29 June 2021. From the January paid February 2022 payment schedule all Gross item of service (IOS) training activity will be included in both the baseline and the current month actuals and all future months.

If the baseline registration has changed, this will be due to retrospective claims.

For the schedule months July 2021 to December 2021 historic report values may be updated to reflect this, as noted above. The activity percentage reported is unaffected as different criteria was applied as appropriate at the time.
