



Annual Certificate of Pensionable Profit/Notification of Estimated Pensionable Profit - Check Your Contributions

Whilst we make every effort to ensure payments are correct, we have been processing a large number of annual certificates this month so please check your March statement to ensure that your contributions are correct.

Also check your contributions are correct if your accountant has submitted a Notification of Estimated Pensionable Profit as we are dealing with a large volume of these forms and it is advisable to spot any errors early on.

Important Dates

March 2022 Payment

Medical Payment date for March: Thursday 31st March 2022 Earliest date from when e-Statements may be available: Monday 28th March 2022

April 2022 Payment

Medical Payment date for April: Friday 29th April 2022 Earliest date from when e-Statements may be available: Tuesday 26th April 2022



COVID Vaccination Records

A number of queries have been raised relating to the difficulty in obtaining exact figures for the number of manual updates for inclusion in the COVID form.

In these instances practices should make their nearest approximation based on their experience of having managed the downloads and associated amendments.

Once we have the finalised figures, a reconciliation will be carried out and if further information is required to validate the figures we will reach out to the practice for assistance.

COVID Funding

The COVID funding first issued in April 2020, against which practices have been submitting claims, is due to end as of the 31st March 2022. Any practice who still has a balance of the original funding remaining will have this reclaimed in early 2022-23 once the Health Boards have provided the finalised position for practices. If your practice still has outstanding receipts you should forward these to the board for validation and subsequent payment prior to 31st March 2022 after which date they will no longer be able to accept.
