Product Safety Report for a Wall Lamp (Batch LB002): risk of electric shock

Summary

The UK Government's Office for Product Safety & Standards (OPSS) has produced a Product Safety Report for a Wall Lamp that does not meet the requirements of the Electrical Equipment (Safety) Regulations 2016 and presents a risk of electric shock. Destruction of the product is recommended.

Action

Mains powered bulkhead lamp, fitted with tails connection to the mains supplied in brown cardboard packaging. Batch number: LB002.

Background

OPSS help manage consumer product safety incidents and provide information on products that present a serious risk to health and safety.

This OPSS Product Safety Report identifies the wall lamp as, "presenting a serious risk of electric shock as there is possible access to live parts through the non-compliant E27 bulb holder, and the item was not adequately earthed. There was no secondary security such as a split washer or starwasher fitted to the earth terminals to prevent from accidental loosening. There was also no information with regards to the rated voltage, frequency, and current shown on the item, as

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required by the regulations. The product does not meet the requirements of the Electrical Equipment (Safety) Regulations 2016."
