A brief update and adding from NSS procurement into the email.

NSS has had some follow up media queries relating to the values of payments made to Go-Centric over the contract period (approx. £15m).

We need to emphasise here that these are payments made in arrears for services delivered – i.e. staff who have been on helplines supporting Test & Protect and vaccination, in addition to the core/bank and other contractor resource we have deployed over the last two ½ years. There has been no payment in advance and we have monitored the staff provided for work done and that has been reconciled against payments made. We need to avoid any spurious link to issues with contracts placed elsewhere in the UK e.g. for PPE where payments may have been made to companies without the necessary capabilities and who have not delivered. The contract with Go-Centric has not operated like that, and we need to make sure that the media does not reach incorrect conclusions as a result of any further information provided.

we may be asked also about how Go-Centric got on the framework and were selected, and we know we have done that in accordance with normal procurement processes (i.e. it was not a section 32 contract). Am sure we have had some media interest in this previously and we had a response back then so if you can work with on any follow-up that would be great.

NB – OFFICIAL SENSITIVE – GO-CENTRIC STAFF HAVE NOT BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSITION RELATING THE COMPANY AND THEIR EMPLOYMENT

I met with their management team yesterday again, also with a second from Marcomms and also SG vaccine policy team to brief them.

- Following the planned sale of the company falling through last week, Go-Centric have confirmed that they have not found financial backing and that Thursday will be their last day providing services (not just to us but to other contracts to). Arrangements for liquidation of the company will be progressed.
- They will be advising staff on Friday morning when the arrive at work and also making a press release too. They will share the press release with us.
- NCC management are confident that this does not pose a serious issue for us at this time in the autumn/winter FCVC programme we were already stepping down contractor and bank resource and can "course correct" for this if required using bank and resources. Had this happened several weeks ago at the peak of the demand for FVCV a more significant impact would have been experienced and different actions (e.g. TUPE of staff to be would have been required.
- Other services e.g. Warm Welcome to Scotland do not use commercial contractor staff and so are not directly affected and NCC has sufficient resource within the workforces for there to be no secondary impact.
- Our ability to surge vaccines is affected, should that be invoked.
- I have agreed that we will take actions within NSS's digital platforms which are accessible by Go-Centric to remove access after close of business on Thursday 1st December and before start of service on Friday 2nd December
- Members of the Go-Centric management team will continue employment into next week to allow for close down activities. This will include arrangements for invoicing for November activity (there may be a request to pay this in a specific timescale).
