
Important Updates

NPCCD - National Primary Care Clinician Database

The NPCCD Medical and Ophthalmic systems are national systems used and maintained by all Health Boards and currently contain details of all GPs and Optometrists/Ophthalmic Medical Practitioners validated to work in the Board area and locum for others. With New CHI in progress and scheduled to go live Autumn 2023, we are exploring further uses of NPCCD as this system will become the "single source of truth" for all GP and Ophthalmic Data.



NPCCD Key Developments:

Medical

- Recent functionality Updates
 - o Indicate mandatory fields for a practice
 - o "Back/Cancel" button improvements
- Currently in Business as Usual.

Ophthalmic

- Community Glaucoma Service and Low Vision Service functionality now in live environment.
- Dates of when these functionalities will be available to users will be confirmed in due course.

Dental

- Scottish Government have confirmed commencement of NPCCD Dental. This will be undertaken using a 3-phase approach.
- Phase 1 development will begin shortly.
- NPCCD project team will be in touch with further information on timelines as soon as these are available.
