NPCCD Key Developments:

Medical

- New CHI went live on 1st November 2023
- Currently Business as Usual
- Continual improvements to the live medical functionality

Ophthalmic

- Cleansing of NPCCD Ophthalmic data is nearing its conclusion and is forecast to be complete in January
- Work is underway to develop functionality within NPCCD Ophthalmic to give optometrists access to the data held about them on the system
- Testing on this with some volunteer optometrists is scheduled to occur in January

Dental

- The NPCCD project continues to grow by building support for a third specialty Dentistry.
- The Dental Project team have been focused on building the first key functional areas management of Dental Practitioner records, Dental Listing records and Dental Service Provisions.
- Ultimately, this work will support more efficient, accurate and centralised management of Dental Listings and Service Provisions.
- We will continue to see significant enhancements across the next two phases scheduled for 2023/24 and 2024/25 of planned Dental development work.
