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Introduction

National Procurement is the Centre of Procurement Expertise for NHS Scotland (NHSS). We provide commercial, logistics and technology solutions to Scotland’s Health and Social Care services. Our national team also provides expert advice and support to our Health Boards (HBs) on procurement matters, working closely with colleagues in HB procurement teams.

We manage national contracts with an annual value of over £1.43 billion and offer commercial solutions to assist NHSS in spending effectively which releases resources into frontline services and patient care. Our contracts and services provide high quality and best value arrangements for the medicines, medical services / consumables, non-medical supplies and services, food, IT services and equipment used within our hospitals and health services

Our National Distribution Service (NDS) is Scotland's largest public sector logistics operation. Our logistics team store and deliver products to help keep Scotland's health and social care operating and work collaboratively with our supply chain team who ensure continuity of supply by working with suppliers and health boards.

Our Technology Service team is the focal point for Purchase to Pay (P2P) solutions and supporting national improvement initiatives and ensuring eProcurement requirements are represented at an NHS strategic level.

The Procurement Reform (Scotland) Act 2014 requires all publicly funded organisations with an estimated annual regulated spend of £5 million or more to develop a procurement strategy and to publish an Annual Procurement Report covering the activities in the relevant reporting period of the procurement strategy.

National Procurement publishes an Annual Delivery Plan linked to our procurement strategy to assure we meet our strategic objectives and ensure value for money is achieved. This annual procurement report will set out the performance of National Procurement against the organisational Strategy and summarise the value delivered through procurement activity.

Foreword and other Reporting Highlights

Foreword

I am pleased to be presenting the Annual Procurement Report as a positive record of National Procurement's performance. The report covers the year from April 2024 to March 2025 (24/25) and focuses on the work of NSS National Procurement (NP) in supporting our Health and Social Care services.

NHSScotland faces financial pressures due to rising healthcare costs driven by an aging population and increased demand for services as well as constrained public sector budgets, which makes efficient procurement essential. By leveraging procurement, NHSScotland can improve care delivery, support NHSScotland's net zero goals, and create positive social impact for communities we serve.

The procurement landscape has become more challenging due to inflation and economic pressures, but these changes have also encouraged greater collaboration across sectors, helping to find improved solutions.

This report demonstrates that we continue to achieve value for money, deliver against our contract workplan and have improved our service delivery to our customers by improving our processes and enhancing our digital capabilities.

This annual procurement report will set out the performance of National Procurement against the corporate strategy and summarise the value delivered through procurement activity. The report documents performance against agreed objectives and strategic targets including those associated with our social, economic, and environmental benefits.

I hope you find this report helpful and that it provides a clear insight to our procurement strategy, our completed and planned activities and some of the great work my team at NP has achieved.

Reporting Highlights

During this reporting period our teams have continued to deliver sustainable and innovative commercial along with supply chain solutions that have a positive impact on Scotland's patients, citizens and our economy.

Working closely with colleagues across NHS Scotland's procurement and clinical teams has been key to successful service delivery and some notable achievements include:

- We secured over £46 Million in monetary benefits to NHS Scotland through our commercial activity against over £1.43 Billion in spend under our management.

- We performed above target on our National Distribution Service operational performance measures assuring improved product availability and on time deliveries for our customers. Our product availability performance was 98.2% against a target of 97.0% and our on-time delivery performance was 99.7% against a target of 99.5%.
- We launched the NHSScotland Procurement Strategy outlining a collaborative, sector-wide vision for procurement services across Scotland's health and care.
- We continue to hold our annual Procurement for Health (P4H) conference that provided an opportunity for over 600 key decision makers from across the healthcare procurement community to meet with our healthcare suppliers.

Looking Ahead

I hope you find the content of this report useful, and that it highlights the scope of the activities our NP teams have delivered over the past year. I want to thank everyone in my team for their continued contributions that have meant National Procurement was able to adapt and deliver our key responsibilities and meet our objectives throughout the year. I am very proud of our accomplishments and the way all the procurement teams across NHS Scotland have continued to work together, always focused on achieving the end goal of improving patient care.

I am sure we can build upon our continued positive performance as we respond to the evolving needs of our stakeholders by embedding a culture of sustainability and delivering commercial solutions to improve the health and social care services for the people of Scotland

Our key focus areas are:

- Developing additional commercial opportunities by delivering our contract workplan to identify secured savings and assist in delivered benefits for our customers.
- Providing strategic leadership in digital procurement building on our systems roadmap.
- Promote and support adoption of the new NHS Scotland Procurement Strategy through our Best Practice Group which will embed the strategic priorities.
- To develop sustainable procurement strategies to support NHS Scotland spend.

Review of Regulatory Procurement Compliance

As a centre of Procurement expertise National Procurement sets out the objectives of our planned regulated procurements to ensure we deliver against our financial, sustainability and community wellbeing objectives.

Our national contracts are designed to support local economic priorities, enhance social value in communities and support policy delivery. Detailed analysis was

undertaken to prioritise and validate the contract activity and develop a fully resourced contract workplan in line with available. The focus across National Procurement Category teams has been to deliver against this contract workplan

All relevant contract strategies are developed with our Commodity Action Panels with stakeholder buy-in to ensure our contracts fulfil user requirements at point of use. A review of each strategy is conducted as part of our governance procedures and managed our Procurement Journey framework

Contracting Activity in Year

Our scope of work covers all regulated procurements with a national aspect and a monetary value of £100K+.

We awarded 81 regulated contracts in the reporting period that have an annual value of £264 million and a full contract term value of £1.3 billion to 414 unique suppliers.

All contracts were awarded in line with our strategy, in compliance with the procurement regulations and taking full account of the Scottish Procurement policy.

Commercial Leadership for NHS Scotland

Central to our operating model is the delivery of effective commercial solutions for our customers and service users as well as managing the spend of NHS Scotland on products and services required to treat our patients. We perform this service in compliance with all public procurement regulations to provide assurance that our business awards are fair and transparent, providing equal treatment to all bidding companies.

We ensure NHS Scotland gets value for money by awarding contracts through open competition, following our approved tendering procedures. Through detailed and robust contracting processes, we work in partnership with our suppliers to assure delivery of critical products, services and medicines at the agreed prices. Our tendering and contractual management approach means that we can deliver substantial savings to the public purse in Scotland.

National Procurement contract owners manage our suppliers to ensure we implement our contracts effectively by developing strategic supplier relationships and assisting our customers in implementing and receiving optimum benefit from our frameworks:

Spend under Management

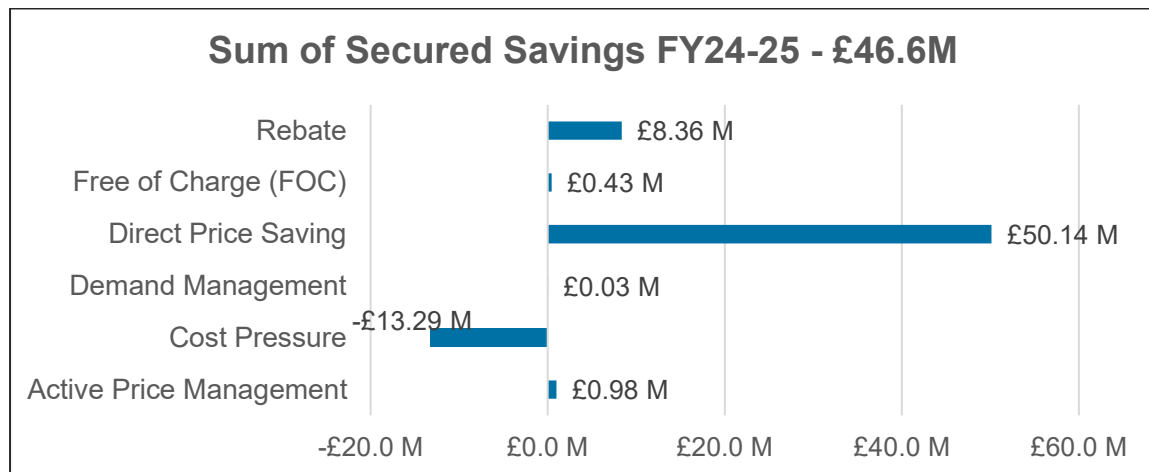
Spend under management is a standard procurement metric. It tells the reader how much of overall organisational 3rd party spend is managed and therefore deemed to be under commercially beneficial terms for the organisation. This could include: lower prices, faster delivery times, dedicated account management, valued customer status meaning that we will be supported in the event of any supply constraints and

be first to benefit from new product and service innovations. Our main way of measuring spend under management is to consult our contract register which is available to view at -

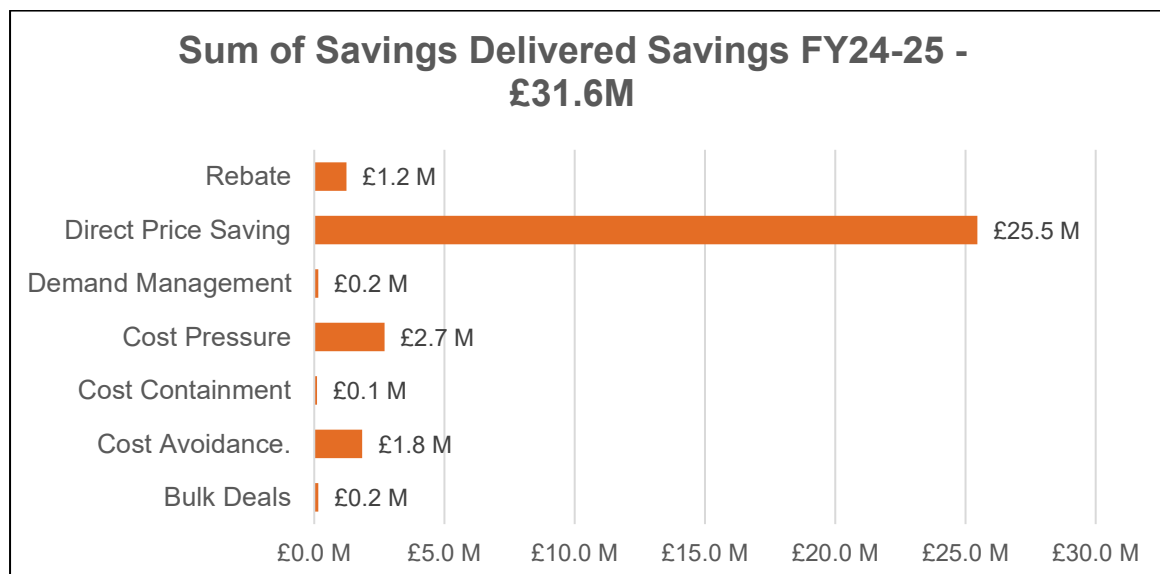

The annual value of our current register is £1.43 billion.

In total our commercial teams secured £46.6m in benefits from our spend under management over the reporting period. The chart below details our secured savings.



In addition to securing new benefits from our commercial and contracting activity we ensure delivery of benefits identified in previous years to ensure these are delivered for Health Board colleagues. The chart below represents the value received from previous years' commercial activities with £31.6m being delivered in the period of report.



Many supply chains have been adversely impacted by cost pressures due to global inflationary environment and there has been a noticeable increase in contract prices for goods and services from suppliers. National Procurement continued to monitor and

manage the volatile inflationary environment encountered within this year and National Procurement teams put plans in place to minimise and mitigate these where feasible. National Procurement teams managed the supplier base to provide an additional £23.8m of secured benefit.

NHS Scotland Procurement Strategy

NHS Scotland Procurement Strategy Launch

NHSScotland has launched its Procurement Strategy (2024-2028), outlining a collaborative, sector-wide vision for procurement services across Scotland’s health and care. This strategy has been developed in collaboration with NHSScotland health boards. It successfully aligns with the strategic objectives of NHSScotland, and the procurement plans of individual boards.

Making the best use of NHSScotland’s spending power is a key focus of this strategy that draws from the Public Procurement Strategy for Scotland which launched in April 2023, with its vision of ‘putting public procurement at the heart of a sustainable economy to maximise value for the people of Scotland

The strategy sets out a framework of strategic priorities designed to guide the development of national and regional Health Board procurement strategies. These include collaboration, embedding sustainable and ethical procurement practices to supply chain resilience. It also addresses the future needs of procurement services, emphasising the transformation of procurement systems and ongoing talent development to navigate the evolving procurement landscape.

Strategic Priority Framework

This framework is linked and mapped to the Public Procurement Strategy for Scotland and its four outcomes: Good for Society, Good for Businesses and Their Employees, Good for Places and Communities, and Open and Connected.



Next year, National Procurement will focus on driving adoption of the new NHS Scotland Procurement Strategy. Our Best Practice Group will develop an improvement plan to integrate strategic priorities into the Procurement and Commercial Improvement Programme (PCIP).

Sustainable Procurement

Climate Change

Our Sustainable Procurement Steering Group (SPSG) continues to be the focal point and core oversight group for sustainable procurement activities across NHSS Procurement teams. Its purpose is to ensure sustainable procurement activities are communicated, planned, and delivered on an NHSS wide basis.

Model Question

NHSScotland Procurement Strategy 2024 – 2028 was published in 2024, confirming ongoing commitments to embedding sustainable and ethical procurement.

National Procurement continue to engage with our suppliers and industry forums and, having trialled a standardised approach in the form of a 'Model Question', feedback concluded that a more bespoke approach would allow for a more effective way of sustainability considerations within tender processes.

In early 2025, a commodity specific strategy was developed with the aim of adopting a structured approach to the consideration of relevant risks (Environmental and social) and opportunities, whilst being relevant and proportionate to the products and services being procured.

The three-year work plan includes a service level matrix, detailing support in a number of the procurement processes including the commodity strategies, pre-tender engagement with suppliers, involvement in commodity advisory panels and the tender and evaluation.

This approach has been well received by internal and external stakeholders and will be implemented throughout 2025-2026 with several key metrics to measure successful application. These metrics will be presented in following years Annual Delivery Plans.

All national tenders within the NHS go through the procurement journey process where all aspects of sustainability are considered during the development of the strategic approach.

Depending on the outcome of this formal review, additional and more detailed assurance supported by evidence may be requested as part of the supplier

submission process including independent audits and evidence of compliance to all relevant legislation, including the removal of all potential slavery links.

Ethical Trading and Modern Slavery

The global glove supply market is closely monitored for ethical trading and labour standards compliance. For our medical examination glove procurement which took place this year, we required all tendering suppliers to provide assurance regarding these standards policies to ensure compliance to all necessary legislation and industry best practice

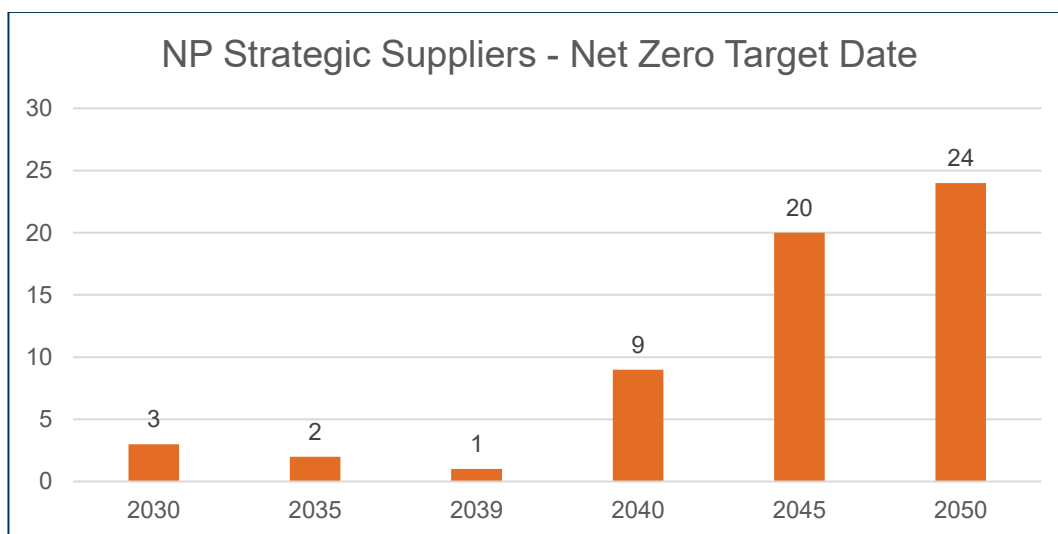
A Supply Chain Integrity Policy (SCIP) was implemented, managed by the supplier’s legal compliance team. This process requires all third-party glove manufacturers involved to undergo a risk assessment based on their nature, materiality, location, product classification, and ownership.

Throughout the contract delivery, continuous checks will be taken against Code of Practice/Ethical Policy/Modern Slavery Statement and labour standards audits completed.

Supplier Sustainability Dashboard

The Scottish Government's net zero emissions target is 2045. National Procurement request Carbon Reduction Plans for all relevant and proportionate tenders in line with mandated requirements in SPPN3/2022 Reporting has been developed to demonstrate the number of our suppliers where Net Zero Plans have been captured.

Development of a reporting suite continues with our supplier sustainability dashboard. National Procurement has captured a Net Zero plan for all our strategic suppliers and 30% of our total contract supplier base with a target to capture over 90% of our contract supplier in this financial year. We will continue to monitor supplier plans and ensure increased compliance with the 2045 net zero target.



Decarbonisation and Renewable Energy

To support NHSS plan of being net zero by 2040 and reducing our carbon footprint by 70% by 2030 we have developed our Decarbonisation and Renewable Energy category team. The core function of this team is to assist NHSScotland Health Boards in the successful conclusion of Heat and Power Purchase Agreements (HPAs) with the aim of reducing energy costs and carbon emissions.

Under the direction of the NHSScotland Climate Emergency and Sustainability Board an Energy Transition Board (ETB) has been established to lead on the following -

- Managing the Energy Transition Workstream of the National Sustainability Action Programme.
- Co-ordinating national support, including funding, to Health Boards for building energy decarbonisation.
- Co-ordinating and overseeing, at a strategic level, a programme of major energy decarbonisation projects for the NHS.

The focus of the ETB is to develop a decarbonisation plan and prioritisation process framework. With the establishment of our Decarbonisation and Renewable Energy team within NSS National Procurement we will be able to support Health Boards with accessing supplies of low-cost renewable energy.

Social Outcomes

The Procurement Reform (Scotland) Act 2014 sets out requirements for public procurers in Scotland to achieve the Scottish Government aims to make the best use of public money and assist the government achieve its overarching purpose and strategic objectives.

For any contract (including Frameworks), over £4M consideration is given whether to include a community benefit clause. Increasing community benefit has been a key focus area this year and to further increase the scope to help improve the economic, social, and environmental wellbeing and assist in the reduction of health inequalities across Scotland. A further measure was introduced to deliver social value in 90% of all procurement contracts worth over £1m.

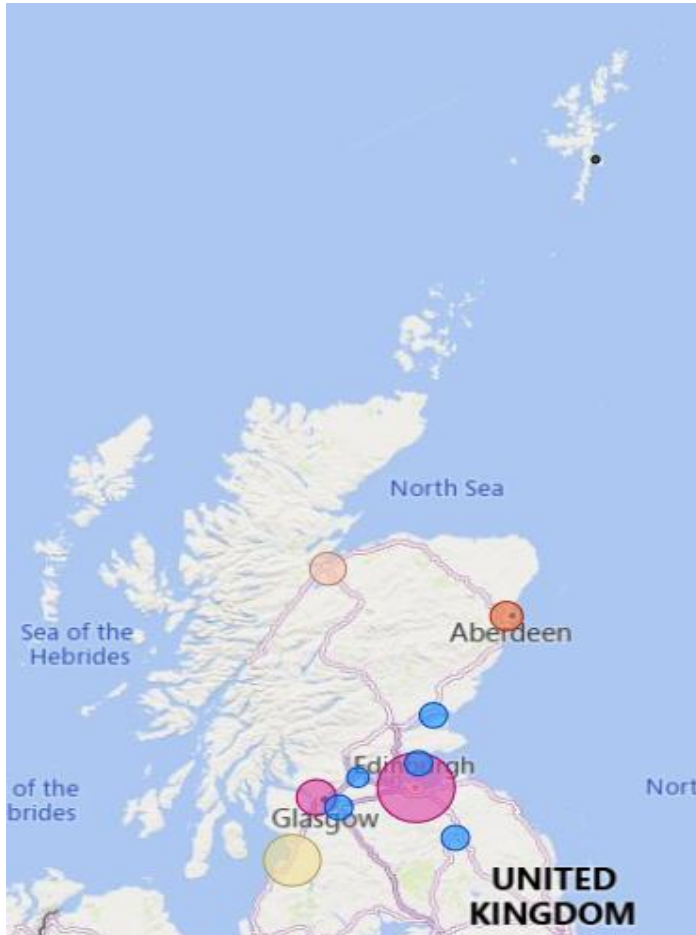
Community Benefits

Our work continues in collaboration with Public Health Scotland to improve the economic, social, and environmental wellbeing of local areas through the Community Benefits Gateway (CBG) Portal, a free and easy to use online service, connecting NHS Scotland suppliers with third sector community organisations in Scotland who are looking for assistance with a variety of needs.

Community Benefits are tangible, positive outcomes which improve the lives of local people and enable communities to thrive. They are vital for boosting employment and

securing the long-term sustainability of communities and increased support for vulnerable people.

Number of Secured Benefits by Health Board



This year the Community Benefits process has been further developed and embedded with the number of suppliers registered on the portal increasing from 510 to 753 and an increase in community benefits secured from 43 to 68.

Community Benefits in the period

Examples of where our suppliers play a lead role through Community Benefit Gateway initiatives include offering to:

- Provide funds to purchase equipment for community garden projects.
- Supply wheelchair equipment to charity the supports sporting initiatives and social inclusion projects designed to positively affect both physical and mental wellbeing.
- Provide staff to support painting of a community family support centre.
- Provide books to a charity support children’s mental health.
- Multiple suppliers providing IT equipment to support several requesting organisations.
- Providing security equipment to keep staff and premises safe.

Fair Work First & The Real Living Wage

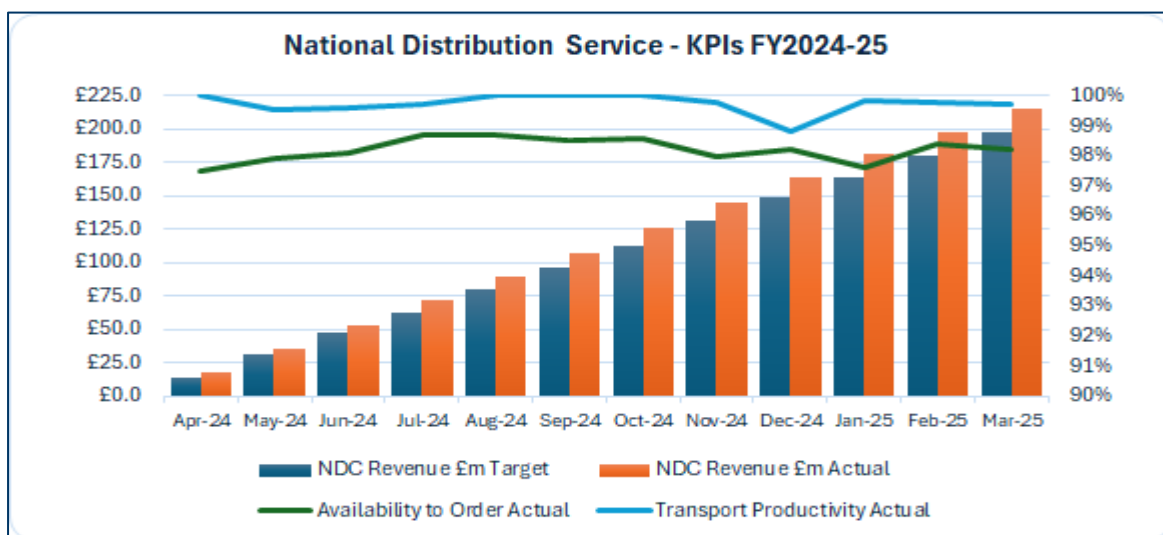
Part of our role is to support Scottish Government policy through procurement. A key policy commitment is to implement Fair Work and Payment of the Real Living Wage in the delivery of public contracts where it is relevant and proportionate to do so <https://www.gov.scot/publications/fair-work-first-guidance/>.

It should be noted that the NP scope in application of these policy commitments is limited due to the global nature of our supply chains and the need to maintain fair and equal treatment to all bidders in line with the GPA & WTO rules.

Managing Supply Chain

Our expert logistics services include distribution, supply chain, warehouse operations and fleet management. We performed above target on our key National Distribution Service operational performance measures assuring improved product availability, this is where a product ordered is supplied to our customer, and on-time deliveries for our customers.

Our product availability performance was 98.2% against a target of 97.0% and our on-time delivery performance was 99.7% against a target of 99.5%. We increased revenue, stock issues to our customers, exceeding our target. (£197million vs £214million)



Supply Chain Performance

Resource has been focused on operational activity to minimise any product shortages. Despite an uplift in warehouse throughput activity our product availability levels of above 98% were achieved. Financial pressures continue to impact across National Distribution Service (NDS) catalogue range in addition to on-going global supply chain challenges due to political and economic challenges over several product categories.

However, through the activity of the combined NDS and health board operational groups several resilience initiatives, particularly around the use of product alternatives and contract compliance have provided commercial assurance and continuity of supply.

To support NHSS financial sustainability the products held in National Distribution Centre were reviewed to ensure commercial optimisation by transitioning Health Boards to best value products. A catalogue rationalisation programme is ongoing to assist in improving warehouse efficiency and remove non-contract products from the catalogue offering.

Invoice Payment Performance

Scottish Government procurement regulations require that suppliers to the public sector, and their sub-contractors, are paid within 30 days of receiving a valid invoice. This prompt payment requirement is mandatory under the Procurement Reform (Scotland) Act 2014.

National Procurement reports on payment performance statistics for suppliers to our National Distribution Service and this performance is reviewed monthly at our Operational Management review meetings.

The table below details our improving performance against this measure within the reporting period of this report compared to the previous year.

Warehouse Operations

Our National Distribution Service (NDS) continue to serve NHS Scotland customers from our three warehouse sites located in central Scotland, where we maintain inventory of over 8,000 products. These supplies comprise the majority of items used daily in hospitals and include consumables that support the Pandemic Influenza Preparedness Programme (PIPP).

Throughout the year, we made 13,000 deliveries and processed over £4.4 million order lines for our customers.

The year marked another significant growth in our Logistics operations. Revenue throughput representing stock issues to NHS Scotland customers, increased by more than £14 million, while our operational costs remained stable. This enabled a reduction in the cost per delivered line to NHS health boards across Scotland. A major contributing factor to lowering our operating cost base was the successful

implementation of measures to significantly reduce external storage costs compared to the previous year.

We invested in upgrading our mechanical handling equipment at all warehouse locations. The new fleet has enhanced efficiency and delivered notable sustainability benefits through lithium battery technology, supporting our green initiatives. Additionally, the advanced safety features of this equipment further strengthen our ongoing commitment to improving health and safety culture.

To facilitate future sustainability advancements, capital investment was secured for a bulk Hydrotreated Vegetable Oil (HVO) biofuel storage unit. HVO is a steppingstone fuel source in supporting the decarbonising of NSS fleet. This project implementation aims to capture and benchmark CO2 emissions from our delivery vehicle fleet in the upcoming financial year.

All our warehouse sites achieved expanded ISO 9001 accreditation, ensuring the maintenance of a robust quality management system (QMS) that complies with ISO 9001 standards. This internationally recognised certification provides a framework for continual operational improvement, enhanced customer satisfaction, and demonstrates our dedication to quality.

The Warehouse Management System was successfully upgraded, enhancing operational efficiency and supporting future improvements.

Digital Transformation

Technology Services

The Technology Services Team continues to be a strategic enabler of procurement transformation across NHS Scotland. In alignment with the NHSS Procurement Strategy the team has delivered key digital initiatives that support operational efficiency, data transparency, and resilience in procurement systems.

The launch of NHS Scotland's 5-Year Digital Roadmap is a key step toward smarter, more efficient procurement. By unifying technology platforms, the roadmap supports better decision-making, cost savings, supply chain resilience, and sustainable, data-driven practices.

During 2024/25, we prioritised the stabilisation and optimisation of our existing procurement infrastructure. This has included the deployment of digital procurement technologies designed to streamline core processes, enhance operational efficiency, and reinforce patient safety.

The team is shaping future procurement systems by gathering requirements and engaging stakeholders across key areas, including Pre-Award systems, Catalogue

Management, Purchase-to-Pay, Reporting, and Integration, building a foundation for a more agile and resilient procurement ecosystem.

Warehouse Management System Upgrade

As part of our ongoing commitment to the National Stock Efficiency Programme, NHS Scotland has successfully completed the upgrade of the national Warehouse Management System used to manage stock in all National Distribution Service warehouses. This critical enhancement significantly strengthens operational resilience, improves inventory accuracy, and ensures the system is equipped to support evolving supply chain demands across NHS Scotland.

The upgraded system enables smarter stock management, better visibility, and more responsive logistics for safer, more efficient care across NHS Scotland.

Digital Transformation

As part of our digital transformation, we have implemented solutions to support our supply chain efficiency programme optimising and automating manual processes.

Our Customer Supply Notice CSN, used to identify and supply issues and product alternatives, has been transformed to provide improved communication, streamlined supply chain updates, and has enabled faster, more accurate responses to supply issues across NHS Scotland, enhancing patient care and operational efficiency.

Further Highlights

Procurement for Health (P4H) Event

Officially supported by NHS National Services Scotland, P4H Scotland – the Procurement Event for Health 2025 – connected buyers and suppliers from across Scotland's healthcare procurement community which is worth over £2.5 billion annually. It offers opportunities for learning, networking, and showcasing products.



This provides an opportunity for the buyer and supplier healthcare procurement community to engage across a range of innovative event features designed to help all participants to explore the initiatives and objectives at the heart of today's healthcare marketplace in Scotland

The event included:

Product Showcases

For the private sector suppliers, the product showcases provide a unique platform to connect with over 600 key decision makers from across the healthcare procurement community. This provided an opportunity for suppliers to place their products and services in front of key personnel and organisations responsible for setting strategy and the operational delivery of the NHS procurement budget across Scotland.

Skills Development Area

P4H Scotland is free to attend for the public sector and has a Skills Development Area that provides procurement staff to enhance their commercial knowledge through a range of CPD Certified training sessions, all of which are designed to support the development of procurement skills and capabilities.

NHS National Services Scotland Pavilion

The pavilion allows attendees to meet National Services and Health Board procurement staff and learn about supplier opportunities and the routes to be taken to engage in the procurement processes. It also promotes further development of partnerships between suppliers and the NHS Scotland procurement community.

Supplier Awareness Sessions

To support some of our equipment contract frameworks being awarded our Medical Equipment team have hosted some Framework Launch Event / Supplier Show and Tell Days where all awarded suppliers were invited to show case their equipment and services to all NHS colleagues.

These launch events are aimed at helping NHS clinical, technical and procurement staff to understand the products and functionality of available equipment. They also enhanced market knowledge of the equipment and services and instilled greater competition and understanding as well as developing innovation in the marketplace. Positive feedback was received from NHS Scotland delegates and our suppliers.

Our People Development

Training

Our Professional Development Oversight group oversees and approves all professional training ensuring a standardised approach and effective use of the available training budget

We have continued to support 21 colleagues in attaining professional procurement qualifications from the Chartered Institute of Procurement and Supply (CIPS), the

recognised body which National Procurement has selected to use to ensure staff are appropriately trained. This significant investment across the procurement team will ensure colleagues have the appropriate skills and experience to carry out their current responsibilities and enable career progression in the organisation. As this has been a new approach for colleagues studying, we will be documenting lessons learned, and these will inform management in making decisions related to our ongoing commitment in supporting colleagues across the organisation develop their skills and ensure all are appropriately trained.

Across our warehouse Operations Team staff have been undertaking Continuing Professional Development (CPD) courses through the Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport (CILT). These courses provide personnel with specialised career development opportunities, linked to their current roles allowing them to enhance their existing knowledge by gaining current industry insights. This investment has seen 9 members of staff successfully complete courses in either Practising Warehouse Management or Practising Inventory Management. A further cohort of 7 individuals have also recently started their studies.

National Procurement as an Anchor Institution

The NHS is viewed as an Anchor institution whose resources and influence help improve the social, economic, and environmental factors impacting local well-being.

National Procurement has a commitment to use our expenditure to deliver better health to our communities and maximise opportunities for Scottish business to compete for our contracted spend.

The nationally led procurement of our home oxygen service, serving 6,500 patients, aimed to modernise delivery, reduce health inequalities, ensure equitable service throughout Scotland, as well as incorporate broader social and environmental benefits.

Our successful supplier Vivasol is a Scottish based company who were awarded a seven-year contract allowing them to sustain their business at a local level, invest in their people and improve working conditions in their premises. The Home Oxygen Service, based in Stirling, uses local based suppliers and services wherever possible and in doing so reinvests in Scotland. This is further amplified through the spend of their employees and their impact on the local community and businesses.

Innovation

The Innovation team engages and directly supports organisations across Scotland that are driving and funding transformative change, both the creation of disruptive technologies and the subsequent adoption and spread of new innovations.

National Services Scotland is a collaborative partner supporting the Accelerated National Innovation Adoption (ANIA) Pathway, led by The Centre for Sustainable

Delivery (CfSD), focused on fast-tracking the adoption of proven technological innovations across NHS Scotland.

This year has seen the roll out of the nationally procured Digital Dermatology solution which provides a 'pass-through' image capture solution that will support referrals created in Primary Care to be sent to Secondary Care.

Business Cases have been approved that will see more than £6 million invested to help people with type 2 Diabetes, stroke patients and babies born with a rare genetic condition.

The team is also supporting ANIA in developing multiple Value Cases to support the potential procurement and implementation of additional diabetes prevention programmes, ambulatory ECG patch monitors, and chest X-ray AI.

In support of Scotland's Chief Scientist Office (CSO) which aims to strengthen Scotland's innovation activities through research and development (R&D), the team have engaged the market in preliminary market consultations and open market competitions aimed at identifying new solutions to solve priority challenges and facilitate research and development in NHS Scotland's Regional Innovation Hubs to help develop them to a market ready state.

In the last year, our team has progressed 9 Pre-Commercial Procurements through various competition stages which initiate the subsequent feasibility studies, prototype development periods.

The Scotland Innovates service continues to provide a route to connect supplier's new ideas with the Scottish Public Sector and NHS Scotland. As well as providing strong links to key stakeholder groups and Innovation leads, it helps inform partner organisations of the current innovation landscape and trends, such as the potential ANIA programme inclusion.

During 2024-2025 we received 67 (55 health specific) potential innovative solutions with 12 (Health Related) of these gaining clinical and stakeholder interest and further engagement including trials and commercial adoption with others that have been signposted to upcoming procurement opportunities.

Humanitarian Aid

Our National Distribution Service supports humanitarian aid working with International Red Cross, WHO, and UNICEF to coordinate and arrange our donations of critically required items.

We supplied 94 Pallets that consisted of:

- 180 Beds, 80 Mattresses, 48 Ventilators plus Consumables, 48 Ventilator Trolleys and 220 Oxygen Concentrators
