**Freedom of Information Reference FOI-2026-3342**

I refer to your Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA) request that we received on 14 April 2026 requesting the following information:

I am conducting research into plant toxicity in the United Kingdom for a public safety publication.

I would be grateful for the following information for the most recent two-year period available:

- The number of recorded incidents involving plant ingestion, exposure, or poisoning
- Breakdown of incidents by region within Scotland
- Any available categorisation of outcomes (e.g. advice given, hospital referral)
- Any data identifying commonly involved plant types or categories
- Any identifiable seasonal trends

Under Section 17 of FOISA Public Services Delivery Scotland (PSD Scotland) does not hold the information that you have requested.

On 1 April 2026 as part of the Service Renewal Framework, NHS National Services Scotland (NSS) and NHS Education for Scotland (NES) have come together to form PSD Scotland. The new organisation is designed to improve service delivery across health, care and wider public services.
