I refer to your Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA) request that we received on 19 August 2026 requesting the following information:

I hope this message finds you well. I am reaching out to request information regarding the mammography scanners installed across all NHS Scotland hospitals and screening vans. Could you please provide the following details:

The number of mammography systems installed in each hospital across all health boards in NHS Scotland.

The supplier name for each mammography system within each health board and the specific hospital in which they are installed, along with the year of installation.

The number of screening vans currently in operation, as well as the supplier name of the screening equipment within each of the 19 vans.

I appreciate your time and assistance in gathering this information. Thank you in advance for your help. Please let me know if you require any additional clarification regarding these requests.

We have now completed the search of our records and can provide you with the following information:

The number of mammography systems installed in each hospital across all health boards in NHS Scotland.

Under [Section 17 of FOISA for "Information not held"](#) Public Services Delivery Scotland (PSD Scotland) does not hold any information on the mammography equipment installed within NHSScotland hospitals as it is owned, managed and procured by the individual NHS Health Boards (HBs). As such, information on the number of mammography systems installed within each hospital is not held by us and would likely be held at individual HB level.

NHSScotland currently operates 22 breast screening mobile units. These units contain 23 mammography systems, as one of the trailers accommodates two mammography units. The supplier of the mammography equipment installed within the mobile units is Hologic Ltd.

From 1 April 2026, NSS and NHS Education for Scotland (NES) joined to form PSD Scotland, enabling transformation in health, social care, and the wider public sector. More information regarding PSD Scotland can be found at the following URL:
