I refer to your Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA) request that we received on 8 August 2026 requesting the following information:

I would like to know how many patients in Scotland have been recorded under each of the following SNOMED CT codes :

1335891000 Blast injury to brain (disorder)

243025006 Injury due to explosive blast from weapon (disorder)
